




# Freedom of Expression

## January to December 2023



The Fundamental Freedoms Monitoring Project (FFMP) systematically monitors the ability of Cambodians to exercise the freedoms of association, expression, and assembly. This dashboard presents the key findings on **freedom of expression** from the FFMP's Annual Report 2023: Cambodia Fundamental Freedom Monitor. In 2023, the FFMP documented 238 incidents across Cambodia involving at least one restriction on freedom of expression, as defined by the three-part test of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR) Article 19.
