MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN

**ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SOCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY FOR SUB-NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC
DEVELOPMENT**

Article 1: Social Accountability

The implementation plan on Social Accountability for Sub-National Democratic Development phase II (2019-2023) was developed in close collaboration between the NCDD Secretariat (NCDDS), Development Partners and NGOs under the National Program Framework for Sub-National Democratic Development. Social accountability is an integral element of governance arrangements and is a process of constructive engagement between citizens and sub-national administrations through which public decision-making and action takes place. It includes all those activities in which citizens and their representatives can advocate for their interests (voice) and thereby check the performance of councils, officials and service providers of Communes/Sangkat, Education (Primary Schools), and Health (Health Centers), District, Municipality and Khan and other services in line with the transfer of functions and resources to Sub-National Administration.

Article 2: Purpose of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) defines the partnership arrangements of the NCDDS and Family Health International (FHI 360) relating to implementation of the implementation plan on Social Accountability for Sub-National Democratic Development activities in target urban areas as specified in Annex 1 and Annex 2, and annual work plan and budget as specified in Annex 3 of this MoU.

The term of this MOU is from the signing date to December 2021. The FHI 360 will seek funding to support the implementation plan on Social Accountability in the target areas identified in Annex I-II and expect to expand to new target areas and new services in parallel with the implementation plan on Social Accountability Plan for Sub-National Democratic Development Phase II (2019-2023). Target areas may be updated annually, based on agreement from both parties.

Article 3: Obligations of the NCDDS

The NCDDS agrees to:



1. Provide instructions to the concerned sub-national administration within the target areas regarding the terms of this MoU;
2. Provide training to the Sub-National Administrations, Councils, technical health officers, technical education officers and relevant local officials within the target areas regarding the I-SAF concept, tools, and processes, in particular, principles of good governance and the downward flow of accountability, the respective roles and responsibilities of the relevant sub-national administrations and demand side to uphold the above principles and support implementation of ISAF activities in the target areas;
3. Support Sub-National Administration to provide Information for Citizens (I4C) posters and booklets to the target areas with technical guidance and/or orientation on how they are to be produced, displayed and used in the ISAF process;
4. Collaborate in providing orientation training on Strategic Plan on Social Accountability to National master trainers of NGO partner which to ensure the alignment of on-going training delivery to provincial NGO partner trainers at each provincial target;
5. Periodically monitor the performance and meaningful participation of the sub-national administration and relevant health and education officials in order to ensure that information dissemination to citizens and the multi-sector scoring process (service providers and citizens) are being implemented in accordance with ISAF supply side operational guidelines;
6. On a quarterly, semester and yearly basis, prepare and share progress reports of the Social Accountability implementation according to the report format as in annex 5;
7. Facilitate and provide technical support to supply side for efficiency and effectiveness of the implementation of Social Accountability from year to year in the target areas.

Article 4: Obligations of the FHI 360

The FHI 360 agrees to:

1. Provide guidance to its FHI 360 staffs and NGO partners regarding the terms of this MoU;
2. Provide trainings to FHI 360's local NGO partners on Social Accountability concepts, tools, and processes; principles of good governance and downward flow of accountability; and the importance of citizen participation; as well as the roles/responsibilities of the relevant sub-national administration and local NGO partners and citizens in the Implementation of Social Accountability Plan phase II;
3. Provide financial support to FHI 360's NGO partners for Social Accountability activities;
4. Periodically monitor on FHI 360 and NGO partners implementation to ensure that the Social Accountability activities are being implemented with participation from Sub-National Administration, and are in accordance with ISAF demand side operational guidelines;
5. Prepare and share with NCDDS and Sub-National Administration of the MOU and yearly work plan of FHI 360's NGO partners in order to ensure well support and coordination in the implementation;
6. On a quarterly, semester and yearly basis, prepare and share progress reports of the Social Accountability implementation according to the report format as in annex 5;
7. Well collaboration with ministries and Sub-National Administration of supply side for the efficiency and effectiveness of the implementation of Social Accountability Plan from year to year in the target areas.

Article 5: Coordination Arrangements



As necessary, both parties intend to hold periodic coordination meetings to:

- Review progress and challenges in implementation;
- Identify constraints and formulate solutions to these constraints in a collaborative manner;
- Discuss and agree on proposed improvements to the process to be incorporated in future phases of implementation; and
- Discuss other matters pertaining to the overall Social Accountability initiatives.

Article 6: Amendment or Termination of the MoU

This MoU may be amended at any time subject to mutual agreement in writing of the two parties. Either party may terminate this MOU without cause upon at least eight weeks prior written notice. The parties will agree in writing on appropriate measures to minimize any disruption to the implementation of the Social Accountability in the target areas.


