THE REGISTRATION OF FOREIGNERS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1958

[Act No. XVIII OF 1958.]

(The 24th March 1958)

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Registration of Foreigners (Amendment) Act, 1958.
- 2. In section 2 of the Registration of Foreigners Act, hereinafter referred to as the said Act —
- (a) for the period (.) at the end of clause (c), a semi-colon (;) shall be substituted;
 - (b) after clause (c), the following shall be inserted as clause(d); namely:—
 "(d) 'immigration official' means any official of the Immigration Department, including a Junior Immigration Assistant."
- 3. After section 2 A of the said Act, the following shall be inserted as section 2B, namely:—
 - "2B. Any immigration official may enter any place or vessel and airest without warrant any person whom he may reasonably suspect of contravening or having contravened or being about to contravene any provisions of this Act or the rules made thereunder."
 - 4. In section 5 of the said Act
 - (a) for the expression "police officer not below the rank of Sub-Inspector and brought before the District Magistrate who shall, by an order in writing, cause the said foreigner to be detained in safe custody" in sub-section (5) the expression "immigration official and be detained by such authority and in such manner as the President of the Union may direct" shall be substituted; and

(b) for the words "the District Magistrate" in sub-section (6) the expression "such authority and upon such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the President of the Uinon "shall be substituted.
